



Get your motorhome ready for winter camping:

With your Malibu motorhome, you can hit the road at any time, even in winter. However, we have put together a list of things you should bear in mind before setting off on your tour in colder outside temperatures:

- Check the heating, boiler and fan in good time before setting off.
- Check the condition of the glow plugs. It is best to exchange them sentence by sentence.
- Check the functionality of the lighting, including the parking lights.
- Care for door and window rubbers with rubber care products without solvents (Vaseline).
- Check whether all technical inspection stickers (TÜV, AU, gas) are still valid.
- Top up the engine and windscreen antifreeze, oil and brake fluid.
- Use windscreen antifreeze, which should be suitable down to at least minus 25 degrees.
- Lubricate the lifting supports with salt water-resistant winch grease.
- Seal the wheel arches and parts of the frame with underbody wax.
- Wash your vehicle, seal it and allow it to dry thoroughly.
- Replace windscreen wiper rubbers.
- Check the starter and on-board battery. If a white layer is visible on the poles, clean the poles and coat them with pole grease. Check the screw contacts for tightness. Even with maintenance-free wet batteries, you should always check the fluid level and top up with distilled water if necessary.

What you should always have with you in winter:

- Torch and jumper cable
- Snow chains
- Snow shovel and broom
- Replacement bulb
- Wooden planks that prevent the lifting supports and tyres from sinking in during thaws
- Ice scraper, de-icing spray for door locks
- Warm work gloves
- Coarse sand or salt as a traction aid
- Ladder for clearing snow and ice from the roof
